



The Outpatient Anesthesia Specialists.

PATIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Providing information.** Patient's and families, as appropriate, must provide, to the best of their knowledge, accurate and complete information about present medical conditions, past surgeries and illnesses, hospitalization, current medications, and other matters relating to their health and anesthesia care. Patients and their families must report perceived risks in their care and unexpected changes in their condition. Patients can help Stat Anesthesia Specialists, Ltd. (Stat) understand their individual needs by providing feedback about their anesthesia services needs and expectations.
- **Asking questions.** Patients and families, as appropriate, must ask questions when they do not understand any aspect of their anesthesia care or what they are expected to do prior to, during, or after their anesthesia care.
- **Following instructions.** Patients and their families must follow all instructions provided by Stat prior to the date of their scheduled procedure (pre-operative instructions) as well as those instructions provided to be followed after their scheduled procedure (post-operative instructions). Patients should communicate any concerns about their ability to follow the proposed plan of anesthesia to Stat. Stat makes every effort to adapt the anesthesia plan to the specific needs and limitations of the patient. When such adaptations to the anesthesia plan are not recommended, patients and their families are informed of the consequences of not following the proposed pre-and post anesthesia plans; consequences may include cancellation of the proposed anesthesia care.
- **Accepting consequences.** Patients and their families are responsible for the outcomes if they do not follow the instructions relative to their planned anesthesia and related healthcare services.
- **Following rules and regulations.** Patients and their families must follow Stat's rules and regulations that are in the place, which are subject to change.
- **Showing respect and consideration.** Patients and their families must be considerate of Stat's staff and property, as well as other patients and their property.
- **Meeting financial commitments.** Patients and their families should promptly meet any financial obligation agreed to with Stat.
